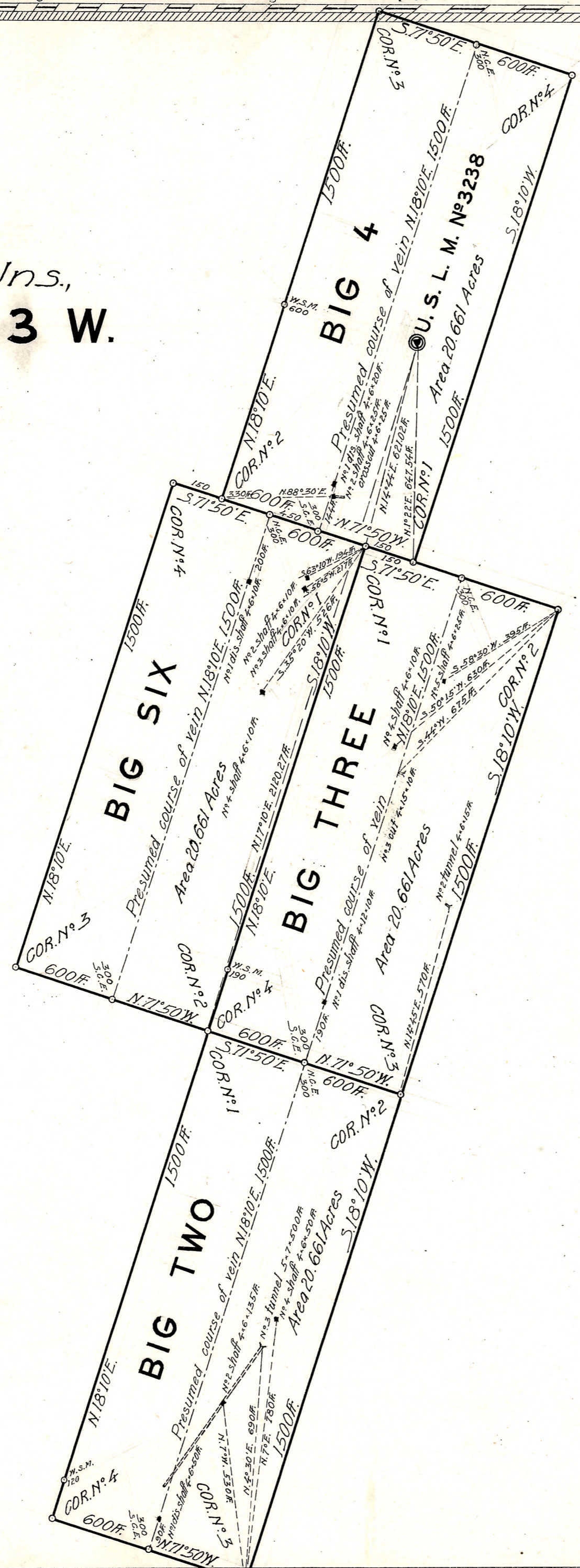

I further certify that Five Hundred Dollars worth of labor has been expended or improvements made upon, said Mining Claims by claimant or his grantors and that said improvements consist of 12 shafts, 2 tunnels, 1 cut & 1 crosscut, total value \$8755. An undivided 1/4 interest, value \$500 in improvement No. 2 on the Big Two lode is credited to each of the claims in this survey.
