Notice of Mining Location.

LODE CLAIM.

To All Whom it May Concern:

This Mining Claim, the name of which is the Isabella Mining Claim, situate on lands belonging to the United States of America, and in which there are valuable mineral deposits, was entered upon and located for the purpose of exploration and purchase by Thomas Smith, George W. Young, and Frank Polson

The undersigned, on the 12 day of February 1900

The length of this claim is 1500 feet, and we claim 1/50 feet, in a Easternly direction and 1/50 feet in a Westernly direction from

the center of the discovery shaft, at which this notice is posted, lengthwise of the claim, together with 300 feet in width of the surface grounds, on each side of the center of said claim. The general course of the lode deposit, and premises is from the West to the East

The claim is situated and located in the Thumb Butte Mining District, in Yavapai County, in the Territory of Arizona, about 1/4 of a mile in a Southernly direction from the old Craster on Willow Creek

The surface boundaries of the claim are marked upon the ground as follows: Beginning at stone monument erected on the hill at a point in a West direction 1/50 feet from the discovery shaft (at which this notice is posted), being in the center of the west end line of said claim; thence 300 feet to a monument of stones being the S. West corner of said claim; thence 1/50 east feet to a monument at the center of the South side line of said claim; thence East 1/50 feet to a monument being at the S. East corner of said claim; thence North 300 feet to a monument at the center of the east end of said claim; thence north 300 feet to a monument, being at the N. East corner of said claim; thence west 1/50 feet to a monument of stone being at the center of the north side line of said claim; thence west 1/50 feet to a monument at the N. West corner of said claim; thence South 300 feet to the place of beginning.
