Articles Of Incorporation
of
Madizelle Mining Company.

Know All Men By These Presents: That we, the undersigned, have this day associated ourselves together for the purpose of forming a corporation under the laws of the Territory of Arizona.

I.

The names of the incorporators are: Andrew A. Blair, Jr., Edward Whitfield, Fred W. Taylor, Charles W. Taylor, Jr., all of the City of Philadelphia, County of Philadelphia, State of Pennsylvania; and George A. Young, of Prescott, County of Yavapai, Territory of Arizona.

The name of the corporation is: Madizelle Mining Company.

The principal place of transacting the business of the company shall be at Prescott, Arizona, and Philadelphia, Pennsylvania, and such other place or places in said Territory or said State or elsewhere as the necessities of the company may require or may be deemed proper.

II.

The general nature of the business to be transacted by this corporation is a general mining, milling, smelting and reduction business; the buying, selling, leasing, bonding, and working of mines, mining claims, water rights, ores and bullion; the building of roads and tramways; to acquire by purchase or any other lawful manner, mining properties,
