

# Notice of Mining Location.

## LODE CLAIM.

To All Whom it May Concern:

This MINING CLAIM, the name of which is the Protection Mining Claim, situate on lands belonging to the United States of America, and in which there are valuable mineral deposits, was entered upon and located for the purposes of exploration and purchase by Geo. W. Young of Prescott Yavapai County Arizona Territory the undersigned, on the 29 day of March 1907.

The length of this claim is 1500 feet and 1 claim 1100 feet in a northerly direction, and 400 feet in a southerly direction from the center of the discovery shaft, at which this notice is posted, lengthwise of the claim, together with three hundred (300) feet in width of the surface grounds, on each side of the center of said claim. The general course of the lode deposit and premises is from the northerly to the southerly.

The claim is situated and located in the Thumb Butte Mining District in Yavapai County, in the Territory of Arizona, about 600 feet in a N. Westerly direction from The Derby Mining Ramp and about 700 ft in a northerly direction from the Derby Minings Company's Quarry Drill.

The surface boundaries of the claim are marked upon the ground as follows: Beginning at a monument of stones at a point in a northerly direction          feet from the discovery shaft (at which this notice is posted), being in the center of the north end line of said claim; thence easterly 300 feet to a monument of stones, being the northeast corner of said claim; then southerly 1500 feet to a monument of stones, being at the southeast corner of said claim; thence westerly 300 feet to a monument of stones at the center of the South end of said claim; thence westerly 300 feet to a monument of stones, being at the southwest corner of said claim; thence northerly 1500 feet to a monument of stones being at the northwest corner of said claim; thence easterly 300 feet to the place of beginning.

All done under the provisions of Chapter Six, of Title XXXII, of the revised Statutes of the United States and of an Act of the General Assembly of Arizona, entitled "An Act Concerning Mines" approved March 20th, 1895, and amended March 2d, 1899, and March 16th, 1901.
